



## Fall 2018 Classes Offered

**BIB 210 - Biblical Exposition:** This is an exposition of a book of the Bible that is not offered in another class. The book that will be studied is at the discretion of the instructor and may vary from year to year. 3 Credits

**BIB 120 - Survey of Old Testament Literature:** This course provides an overview of every book of the Old Testament and gives attention to special issues such as Creation, the covenants, and the prophecies that lead to Christ's first and second comings. The student is taught how to apply the practical principles of the Old Testament to Ministry and practical Christian living. 3 Credits

**ENG 110 - Writing and Research:** This course covers basic writing and research skills needed for college level work. Students will learn the fundamentals of effective writing. The skills learned in this class will aid students in every other class requiring written papers and research. Students will also gain life skills learning how to research information. 3 Credits

**HUM 110 - Principles of Worship 1:** This course will look at worship from a broad aspect, examining the various expressions of worship, both individually and corporately, as well as leading a corporate worship service. Students will be challenged to examine their understanding of worship and their personal expressions of worship. 1 Credit

**PHL 110 - Philosophy of Ministry:** This class will focus on foundational ideas, attitudes, worldviews and objectives for Christian life and ministry. Special emphasis will be placed on developing a personal Biblical world view, and on making ministry a lifestyle. 3 Credits

**SOC 110 - Foundations for Life:** This course is designed to provide information that is foundational to college academic success and personal, social, and spiritual growth. Topics are focused in four areas: college-level academic skills, life management skills, relationship issues, and personal spiritual development. 3 Credits

For individual classes, tuition is \$135 per credit (e.g. \$405 for a 3 credit class). Anyone who wishes to audit a class would pay \$101.25 per credit.

For former ITE graduates who wish to earn their associate degree, tuition is \$360 per class (\$120 per credit). Talk with Taunya about what classes you will need to complete your degree.

Students who enroll in classes this year and then enroll as a full-time student for the 2019-20 and/or 2020-21 school years will have the cost of the tuition they paid this year deducted from the semester in which the class(es) they successfully completed is(are) offered again. (Students must pass the class for tuition to be deducted.)
